

MYSTERY PROJECT

Step 10.

First step is to make sure your stitchery is trimmed to 8 ½" x 8 ½".

You will need a collection strips in 2 colour ranges. I chose reds and greens with 1 strip in yellow.

Cut one each of the green strips: 2" x 8 ½"; 1" x 9 ½"; 2 ¾" x 11 ½"; 1 ¼" x 12 ¾"; 2 ½" x 13 ½".

Cut one each of the red strips: 1 ½" x 10"; 2 ½" x 10"; 1 ¾" x 12 ¾"; 1" x 14"; 3" x 16".

Cut one in a contrasting colour, or pick a colour from your strips for across top of block: 3" x 16".

Press after each addition with all seams towards strips.

Join the green 2" x 8 ½" strip to right hand side of stitchery.

Add the red 1 ½" x 10" strip along the bottom of work.

Join the green 1" x 9 ½" strip to right hand side, and then the red 2 ½" x 10" along the bottom.

Join the green 2 ¾" x 11 ½" strip to side, and then the red 1 ¾" x 12 ¾" along the bottom.

Add the green 1 ¼" x 12 ¾" strip to side, and then the red 1" x 14" along the bottom.

Finally, join the last green strip to side, and then the last red strip across the bottom.

To finish off, sew the yellow strip along top of block.

NOTE** the E will be added much later, so that it overlaps another piece on the left.
