

MYSTERY PROJECT

Step 4

Scrap fabrics

One 4" strip of fabric (by width of bolt)

Paper backed Fusible webbing

Cut the 4" strip for border and crosscut two 9" strips and two 10" strips.

From scraps, cut four 5" squares.

Make up the corner blocks: Place two squares RS together and draw a line diagonally down the centre. Sew down $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from line on either side. Cut along the line, open out pieces and press. Lay them RS together, matching up the centre diagonal seam, with the allowance in opposite directions. Draw a line through the other diagonal. Again, sew down $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the line on both sides. Cut through the line and open out the square. Press.

Snip off all the 'ears'. You need four of these quarter triangle squares.

Join one to either end of the 10" strips.

Sew the 9" strips to top and bottom of stitchery. Press seams towards border. Pin and sew the sides strips, making sure to match up the joining seams. Press seams allowance towards border.

Turn pattern over to wrong side on light box and trace 'P' from the back, onto paper side of fusible webbing.

Press onto wrong side of scrap fabric. Cut out on the lines. Remove paper and place the 'P' as shown in photograph. Press.



For step 5 you will need:

10" x 11" cream tonal fabric and flannelette

DMC in red, plus a dusky pink and green, light gold, very dark brown and ecru.
