

MYSTERY PROJECT

STEP 6

Sew a pair of the large rectangles together along the 4 ½” side. Press. Repeat with other pair and then match them together to form the 4-block square.

Sew this square to top of stitchery.

Join one of the 17” strips to the left side.

To make the centre ‘ladder’ strip, join the small pieces as follows: Begin with a 3¼” x 3½” piece, and add a 3½” square; to this, add a 2½” piece, followed by a 1½” piece. Continue adding the rest of the fabrics, working from small to large. Press and sew to left side of work.

Finally, add the remaining 17” strip.

Reverse the ‘S’ pattern and trace onto paper backed fusible webbing. Cut out roughly and iron onto WS of chosen fabric. Cut out on the line, peel off paper and place as shown. Press firmly and blanket stitch around edges.

For step 7 you will need:

Cream tonal fabric for stitchery 9” x 10” plus pella or flannelette to back.

Red DMC

6 scraps of fabric: one @ 7” x 2”; two @ 6” x 1¼”; two 2” squares; one @ 1” x 3”.

DMC to match all 6 fabrics.
